Space to be allocated is 10' x 10'. One table and two chairs will be provided for each vendor. Space will be allocated on a first come first serve bases. Vendor shall be responsible for all other supplies and materials needed for their operation including but not limited to additional tables, chairs, tent, displays, cash registers, extension cords and lighting. SIX FLAGS GREAT ADVENTURE DOES NOT GUARANTEE ELECTRICAL SERVICE. Vendor needs to abide by all Six Flags safety rules and regulations as well as OSHA (Occupational Safety and Health Administration) regulations.

Vendor will under no circumstances produce or offer for sale any article bearing the wording "Six Flags", "Six Flags Great Adventure", "Great Adventure", any symbol belonging to Six Flags Inc., or any combination thereof.

Vendor is not permitted to sell items that compete with the sales of the Six Flags Great Adventure Retail department, which include, soda, water, candy, light-up toys, henna tattoos, face painting, and more.
